



DOPI, DEPO, PODI & ROPI

The use of "dopi", "depo" and "podi" encountered when opps interfered over a 4nt asking bid from partner.

This refers to the following: Your partner has bid 4nt, after you have agreed on a suit. The opponents interfered with a bid of 5D.

DO = double with 0 controls/aces (depending on your system)

PI = pass with one, and bid the next suit with 2, etc.

Depo - this again is over NT interference, usually used at the 6 level.

DE = Double with an even number

PO = Pass with an odd number

Podi - a different way, tho works equally as well.

PO = Pass with no controls

DI = Double with 1 control, bid up the line with 2 or more, etc.

ROPI

RO = Redouble with no controls

PI = Pass with one control west from an odd number of cards.
